# 7. PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY (PROW)

i) MS/LT – Advised they had liaised with Breage & Germoe Bridleway Association. Issues were raised with BP71, BP8 which is blocked in the middle, this will be reviewed and a report brought back to Council. BP 82 & 39 are subject to further evidence gathering to look at state of paths, whilst BP 39 & 40 were deemed not to be blocked.

TW - The DMMO relating to Tregonning Hill, was discussed, it was noted that the Council agreed to be bound by the original Inspectorate decision and that further comment would not be made.

TW- Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009 is up to date with all changes known to be in force on or before 02 July 2025 **8.HIGHWAYS** 

- i) AB reported that despite CC stating W252123043 We have now carried out works and have made the reported issue safe. That nothing had occurred, the clerk will follow up with CC.
