

Breage Parish's Landmark Tree, a Tilia cordata -small leaved lime donated by The Forest for Cornwall, was planted on Monday 29 November during National Tree Week that runs from Saturday27 November to Sunday 5 December in the Breage Parish Council Cemetery, a Cemetery for the whole Parish, to provide a poignantly touching link between the living and the departed. There is full viewing access to all in the Parish.
